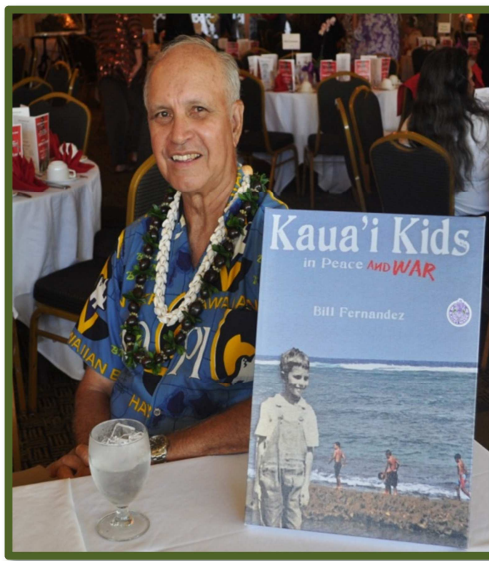


Book Launch Party for

Author **Bill Fernandez** (*Rainbows Over Kapa'a*) has another book of his adventures:

Kaua'i Kids in Peace and War.

Enjoy his small kid adventures in Kapa'a, Kaua'i, in the 1930s when he tried to find Santa Claus in the mountains, challenged sugar cane trains, slid down waterfalls, and played naval war against Russian kids in tin canoes. Then Japan bombed Pearl Harbor and Bill learned that his neighbors, family, and friends faced serious racism from America because they were Japanese. Gas masks, curfews, and rationing replaced his tin canoe days. He learned to shine GI shoes and bring cigarettes to machine gun nests by his home. Part II is dedicated to the Nisei soldiers.

Enjoy Bill's oli, the beautiful slide show, and his singing while you go back in time to hukilau and the dramatic war years which changed his life.
